



AP | PCU BRIDGE TROPHY 2024

Rules and Regulations

A. Type of tournament:

The tournament will be held as a Duplicate bridge tournament in a Round Robin on Saturday. The finals on Sunday will decide the winner of the trophy.

B. Eligibility:

- Teams consist of 4 (to 6) players.
- A team must represent an Institution of Higher Education and preferably field a minimum of one player per team that is an active student at the participating Institution of Higher Education in the academic years 2023-24 or 2024-25.
- A team may be completed with alumni or friends of the participating institution of higher education.
- A team may be composed of players from different higher education institutions of a same country.

C. Ranking System:

During the matches, every team will write down the score on the score sheet and enter the score into a bridgemate. During half time and after full time scores are compared to determine the final score into IMP's and VP's. The following system shall be applied in order to determine the ranking in the group stage on Saturday:

1. total of VP's after 5 matches
2. If equal, the total number of IMP's after 5 matches
3. If equal, the mutual result
4. If the ranking still cannot be determined, it will be determined by allotment

On Sunday, the finals will decide the winner of the tournament

D. The latest version of the general regulations published on the website of the World Bridge Federation (<http://www.worldbridge.org>) will apply to this tournament, as amended and advised by the PCU Committee.





Please take attention to following supplementary rules:

- o Always be on time!
- o Slow play will not be tolerated
- o Remain seated until the change is announced!
- o Bridge mates will be used at all events.
- o Leave the boards, the bidding boxes and the score sheets on the table.
- o Be nice to your partner, opponents, officials of the tournament and others...
- o Follow the ALERT procedure!
- o If you play any convention that might require defense by the opponents, be ethical and pre-alert.
- o If you play any signal that is not considered as standard, be ethical and explain this to opponents.
- o Always provide full information about any convention you play when asked by the opponents.
- o HUM and brown stickers are not allowed (please check with TD if you are not sure about conventions you use).
- o Psychics in forcing strong openings are not allowed!
- o In case of appeal, the Chief Director will appoint an Appeal Committee on site.
